

Responding to today's professional demands

EBB France recruits and trains dancers with strong versatility in both classical and contemporary dance, a fundamental requirement for today's international choreographers and major companies.

The training aims to develop:

- a clear and solid classical technique,
- an immediate adaptability to contemporary movement languages,
- the ability to move seamlessly between repertoire and creative processes.

This dual expertise significantly expands professional opportunities and prepares dancers to approach auditions with confidence and clarity.



Admission from Age 15+

We welcome dancers starting from the age of 15 to 16, particularly those who wish to pursue the **Diplôme d'Études Chorégraphiques (DEC)**. Younger dancers receive careful pedagogical support, and benefit from integration with more advanced peers while developing at their own pace.

EBB France allows dancers to enroll in the official DEC curriculum while gaining immersive stage experience within the Junior Ballet structure. This partnership ensures a balance between institutional academic rigor and **professional performance exposure**.


TRAINING STRUCTURE

A professional working rhythm

The weekly structure reflects the rhythm of a professional company:

- Mornings: technical classes (classical and contemporary)
- Afternoons: rehearsals, creations, repertoire work, and workshops

Dancers work daily on technique, musicality, physicality, and interpretation, while being confronted with the concrete demands of stage performance.

Each season, EBB France collaborates with numerous international choreographers.

Dancers take part in original creations, repertoire reconstructions, and intensive workshops.

These collaborations provide:

- real immersion in creative processes,

An external artistic eye at the highest international level
EBB France benefits from the continuous involvement of an exceptional professional network, offering dancers a direct connection to the realities of today's international dance scene.

Through artistic collaboration, mentorship, and regular external feedback, renowned figures such as Goyo Montero and Marco Goecke maintain an active artistic dialogue with the structure.

Their presence and artistic input contribute to shaping dancers who are responsive, adaptable, and artistically engaged.

In addition, ballet masters from the Paris Opera Ballet, as well as ballet masters and rehearsal directors from major international companies, regularly bring their professional perspective to EBB France.

A professional standard aligned with major companies

These external artistic eyes ensure that:

- dancers are evaluated according to current professional company standards,
- artistic work remains aligned with international expectations,
- dancers develop clarity, rigor, and adaptability in their performance and rehearsal processes.

This ongoing dialogue between EBB France and the professional world allows dancers to be seen, guided, and prepared well beyond the school environment.

National Dance Diploma (DEC – Optional)

Through its partnership with the CRR Pau Béarn Pyrénées, EBB France works with state-certified professors and national exam jury members, ensuring rigorous academic supervision in dance studies, anatomy, music, and choreographic culture for dancers pursuing the French National Dance Diploma (DEC).

The DEC academic is supervised by state-certified professors from the CRR Pau Béarn Pyrénées, all actively involved in national examinations and higher dance education.



About the Program

PROFESSIONAL OPPORTUNITIES Toward Company Engagement

EBB France functions as a professional springboard, offering dancers continuous exposure to the realities of company life.

The Junior Ballet maintains a regular performance program throughout the season, presenting works by international choreographers alongside major classical repertoire, in both classical and contemporary styles.

Performances take place in the four main theatres of the city, as well as during regional and national touring engagements.

Through this sustained artistic activity, dancers benefit from:

- frequent stage experience in professional conditions,
- direct involvement in creation processes and repertoire productions,
- personalized audition preparation,
- regular contact with choreographers, artistic directors, and companies.

For some dancers, the transition to professional engagement happens quickly.

For others, the Junior Ballet serves as a crucial consolidation phase, allowing them to refine their artistic profile, gain visibility, and enter a company with confidence and maturity.

Health & Performance: A Dedicated Team of Experts

As Artistic Director and a former professional dancer, I believe that **high-level training must go hand in hand with high-level care**. At **EBB France**, we are proud to collaborate with a team of four outstanding health professionals based in central **Pau physiotherapists, osteopaths, nutritionists and mental performance coaches** who also work with **top athletes, including the regional rugby team**. Their support is both exceptional and personal.

Many of our dancers join the program with existing physical conditions or **postural imbalances that require professional follow-up**. Every assessment is done with precision using high-end medical equipment, and all treatments or recommendations are based on real diagnostic insights. This close partnership allows us to provide preventive care, tailored physical re-education, and immediate access to exams in case of injury.

Our healthcare team also provides crucial guidance on nutrition and mental preparation. They work directly at our studios on a regular basis, carrying out individual check-ups to ensure that each dancer is not only artistically strong, but physically and mentally equipped to reach **their full potential**.

Residence life & rules CAF housing support

At EBB France, we understand how important it is to support young dancers as they begin to live independently. That's why we've partnered with **Canopy Residence**, a modern, secure housing solution offering private studios with kitchenettes, access to a fitness room, co-working spaces, and peaceful surroundings. Nestled in a **beautiful park between the city center and our studios**, it provides an ideal balance of focus, comfort, and autonomy.

Some older students, however, prefer to live in shared apartments downtown. For this, we collaborate with several trusted local real estate agencies to help students find safe and affordable housing.

Thanks to their enrollment in a professional dance education program, **all students are eligible for CAF housing aid (Caisse d'Allocations Familiales)**. Our team assists with the paperwork to ensure students benefit from this monthly support, which significantly reduces living costs.

About the Program



TUITION, FEES & PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Season September 2026 – July 2027

The EBB France Junior Ballet Program offers a highly competitive tuition rate in relation to the scope, intensity, and professional opportunities provided throughout the season.

Few programs combine daily high-level training, continuous stage performances in classical and contemporary repertoire, international workshops, and individualized professional mentoring within a single professional framework.

1. Full Program (September – July)

- Annual Training Fee: €7 800
- Registration Fee: €500 (one-time, non-refundable)
- Visa Support & Administrative Assistance: €200 (for international dancers, if applicable)

The annual training fee covers a full professional season, including:

- daily high-level training in classical and contemporary dance,
- rehearsals, creations, and Junior Ballet productions,
- regular performances in city theatres and touring engagements,
- nine international workshops included,
- artistic mentoring and individualized professional guidance throughout the season.

2. Six-Month Program (On Request)

EBB France offers a six-month professional training option, available upon request and subject to artistic evaluation and availability.

- Six-Month Training Fee: €5,800
- Registration Fee: €500 (one-time, non-refundable)
- Visa Support & Administrative Assistance: €200 (if applicable)

This option provides concentrated access to the program, including training, rehearsals, productions, workshops scheduled during the selected period, and professional mentoring.

The six-month program is priced at a higher monthly rate due to its flexible structure and intensive professional integration.

3. Private Classes & Individual Coaching (Optional)

EBB France offers high-level private coaching for dancers seeking individualized and targeted artistic and technical support.

Private sessions may focus on:

- classical technique refinement and variations,
- contemporary technique and floorwork,
- repertoire coaching,
- audition preparation,
- physical conditioning and injury prevention.

Private Class Fees:

- €80 per hour (individual session)
- Package of 5 sessions: €380
- Package of 10 sessions: €720

Private classes are scheduled in coordination with the pedagogical team and tailored to each dancer's specific objectives.

4. Housing & CAF Financial Support

Students enrolled in the EBB France Junior Ballet Program may be eligible for CAF housing assistance (Caisse d'Allocations Familiales), subject to individual eligibility and administrative approval.

After CAF support, the average monthly housing cost in Pau generally ranges between €150 and €250, depending on the type of accommodation and the student's personal situation.

EBB France provides guidance and administrative support to assist both French and international students with housing procedures and access to available accommodation solutions.

5. Scholarships

A limited number of scholarships may be available, depending on the student's family income level (family coefficient) and according to the same eligibility criteria and assessment scales applied by public financial aid institutions.

Scholarship allocation is reviewed on a case-by-case basis and subject to availability.
